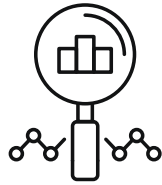

Admission Requirements

Our ELMSN students are the best and the brightest. The following are qualifications for admission to the program:

- Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.
- GPA Requirements. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 based on the last 60 credit hours of college coursework, including graduate coursework, attempted and accepted.
- A minimum science GPA of 3.0 is required. The science GPA is based on the highest grade earned in the last 15 years in the following courses. Grades earned in these courses more than fifteen years ago will require the courses to be retaken or reviewed for acceptance.

 - Anatomy and Physiology II (BY210/210L)
 - Principles of Chemistry (CY103/103L)
 - Microbiology (BY206/206L)
 - Pathophysiology for the Health Professions (HS 415)

 - Abnormal Psychology (PY 309)

Tuition

Tuition is \$790 per credit hour plus any additional program and university fees. Brenau offers a 10% discount on all courses to veterans, retirees and dependents of active duty personnel.*

*Students must complete Brenau's Military Status Affidavit and provide supporting documentation.
