Admission Requirements

Our ELMSN students are the best and the brightest. The following are qualifications for admission to the program:

- Non-nursing bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 based on the last 60 credit hours of college coursework, including graduate coursework, attempted and accepted.
- A minimum science GPA of 3.0 is also required. The science GPA is based on the most recent grade earned in the last 15 years in the following courses. Grades earned in these courses more than fifteen years ago will require the courses to be retaken or reviewed for acceptance.

 - Anatomy and Physiology I (BY209)
 - Anatomy and Physiology II (BY210)
 - Principles of Chemistry (CY103)
 - Microbiology (BY206)
- Non-Sciences:
 - PY 202 Human Growth and Development
 - MS 205 Introduction to Statistics

Tuition

Tuition for the ELMSN program is \$885 per credit. The 68credit ELMSN option comes to \$60,180 and the 77-credit ELMSN degree with Pre-FNP track is \$65,065. Additional fees may apply. Students must also purchase books and materials. Tuition and fees are subject to change. Brenau offers a 10%

discount on all courses to veterans, retirees and dependents of active duty personnel.*
